Part of Maytag's new line of Energy Advantage Washers and Dryers, the MAH22 is a true front-load washer complete with glass door and Energy Star seal that reduces operating costs – and cuts drying time. This new model is yet to be tested in the market place as it has just arrived. While the initial bugs that accompany any new model are worked out, Hi-Rise is selling and operating these washers cautiously. ✓ DON'T CAUSE CONGESTION!

Your tub should be no more than a little over half full to allow your wash to move around & come in contact with the soap & water during the wash cycle.

✓ A LITTLE GOES A LONG WAY!

The less soap, the brighter the wash – so don't add too much detergent.

 ✓ BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR!
Take your clothes out of the washer as soon as the load is finished.
